Preparing for a Fire Safety Inspection

1. Collect copies of previous inspection reports

2. Collect proof of system service and inspections

3. Make appointments for any outstanding safety and heat systems maintenance

4. Protect special hazards

5. Clear hallways and stairwells

6. Store flammable and combustible materials properly
7. Store incompatible chemicals separately

8. Ensure quick and easy entry for the fire department

9. Make sure the fire department can access water

10. Label and maintain electrical system components

11. Use extension cords appropriately
12. Ensure computers have power strips with surge protectors

13. Test exit signs and directional lighting

14. Assess fire extinguisher locations

15. Assess sprinkler head clearance

16. Post any required signage
